13.07.23 Replacing Bench in Church Square / Maintenance of the Pump

The Village Local History Recorder has advised that this is a historic bench that swings over to a table and bench. Proposal to restore bench instead of replacing it.

A Parishioner has proposed that as this is a historic bench would it be better if the bench was moved to Millennium Green to protect it from theft as being historic it must have some value? It is currently padlocked to the Pump in Village Square. If the bench is moved then it could be restored at the same time and then a new bench be purchased to put in its place.

Also the Pump needs to be repainted – the Parishioner advised that they have some Hammerite dark (forest) green and Hammerite black paint and would be happy to strip the pump and repaint.

This would apply except for loading
- 2. The Social Club has offered £200 to put towards seating and a table for the forecourt. You may have noticed the last Sunday in May when the Bar was opened and had several tables out front, enjoying the sunny afternoon and music. Please would the PC consider using CIL money to enable the Village Hall to have more than one table and seat (maybe picnic style) that is accessible, and perhaps a parasol or two for shade.
