



# Welcome



Dear friends,

Firstly, a thank you to all who contributed to our poppy 'waterfall' at

Holton for this year's Remembrance Sunday - it was a very beautiful 'veil' of remembrance through which to enter the church. Those of you who know your Bibles will know that when Jesus died on the cross, the veil of the Temple in Jerusalem was said to have been torn in two, signifying the end of the old Law and the beginning of a new resurrection life in Jesus. In a sense, going through the poppy veil felt like leaving the pain and sorrow of the past behind to remember that all who die in the love of Christ will be with him for eternity. That is what we wish for all who have died in the pain and suffering of war and violence throughout the last century and beyond.

From remembrance we enter, in December, into that strange time of waiting known as Advent - waiting for the birth of Jesus at Christmas. And yet we also remember all the Christmases we have ever known, good or bad, and what those Christmases are going to lead to in just a few short months at Easter. Each year we live through this kind of compression of past and future as we trace all the events of Jesus' life and

how they relate to the experiences of our own lives over the years.

One sad experience that several of our Suffolk churches are going through at present is a renewed attempt on the part of lead thieves to strip our churches of any remaining lead. We have still not managed to replace what was stolen from the roof of SSM over 2 years ago - not because we haven't managed to raise the money, but because we now can't tie the roofers down to come and do the job!

If you spot any suspicious activity around our churches (other than our Churchwardens going in and out!), please report it to the police on either 101 or 999. Please do not approach anyone who seems to be doing anything illegal, but go and phone as soon as you can. If possible, keep a note of what they look like and any car that might be linked to them, along with its registration. Thank you for being good neighbours in this way.

I hope this Christmas will be a very good one for you. Come and join us if you can to celebrate our Saviour's birth.
